

EU RoHS and WEEE Position Statement



On January 27, 2003, the European Parliament and the Council of the European Union (“EU”) adopted Directive 2002/95/EC on the Restriction of the Use of certain Hazardous Substances in Electrical and Electronic Equipment (RoHS), and Directive 2002/96/EC on Waste Electrical and Electronics Equipment (WEEE) with the purpose of reducing the environmental impact of waste electrical and electronic equipment. Both were later recast by Directives 2011/65/EU and 2012/19/EU respectively. All VIAVI products being placed on the EU market conform with these directives.

On March 31, 2015, Directive (EU) 2015/863 was adopted to increase the number RoHS substance restrictions; these additional restrictions apply to monitoring and control instruments from July 22, 2021. VIAVI has established a program to ensure that from July 22, 2021, all VIAVI products being placed on the EU market conform with (EU) 2015/863.

VIAVI is committed to compliance with the RoHS and WEEE Directives and minimizing the environmental impact of its products.
